DAY-WISE ITINERARY

Day 01 –

Arrive in London, the capital of England and the United Kingdom.

Welcome! Today we board our flight to one of the most beautiful cities known for its rich culture, cosmopolitanism and fascinating history - London the capital of England. On arrival, get greeted by your professional tour manager outside arrival hall, who will later escort you to your hotel. Check in and relax in the comforts of your hotel.

Overnight stay at hotel in London.

Meal Plan: Dinner

Day 02 –

Guided city tour of London with Changing of Guards. Visit Tower of London. Photo stop at Statue of Basaveshwar

Today after breakfast proceed to explore the city of London with your expert local guide. You will see important landmarks like the Big Ben, Houses of Parliament, Westminster Abbey, Trafalgar Square, Piccadilly Circus, Tower Bridge, River Thames, Hyde Park and many more. Witness the Changing of the Guards at Buckingham Palace (subject to operation).

Later visit the most famous place in London known as Tower of London which houses the exquisite crown jewels including the Kohinoor diamond and many other British national treasures. You can enjoy the beautiful view of the Famous Tower Bridge. Later group will have opportunity to take photo stop at Statue of Basaveshwar. The statue of 12th century Indian Philosopher "Basaveshwar" who pioneered the idea of democracy was erected on the bank of River Thames, in the London borough of Lambeth.

Day 03 –

Visit Lord's Cricket Ground. Visit to the famous Madame Tussauds Wax Museum. Ride the London Eye.

Today after Breakfast we proceed to first visit the Lord's Cricket Stadium - the Mecca of Cricket, where you will get to see the museum of cricket. Lord's is the most famous cricket Ground in the world, steeped in over 200 years of history and tradition. Walk through iconic parts of the ground including the Grade II*-listed Victorian Pavilion, the world-famous Long Room, the Players' Dressing Rooms, the dramatic J.P. Morgan Media Centre, and the MCC Museum, home of the Ashes Urn – cricket's best-known artefact. Next proceed to visit the renowned Madame Tussauds wax museum. Be enthralled by the world's largest wax collection of famous personalities. Next, visit London eye, one of the many iconic highlights of the city. Enjoy scenic views of the city while you ride the London eye. It is one of the most popular tourist attractions in the United Kingdom, standing at 135 meters tall overlooking the river Thames and the beautiful city of London.

With its famous tapering cast iron tip, the Eiffel Tower is not just the symbol of Paris but of all of France. Next, we proceed take a romantic cruise down the river Seine, one of the world's most scenic cruise, flanked by exquisite monuments like Notre Dame, Eiffel Tower, Louvre, Orsay Museum and many more. Gliding under one bridge to one another with a view of the finest monuments in the heart of bustling Paris.

Day 06 –

Visit Palace of Versailles – Greatest Achievements in French 17th Century Art. Visit Louvre Museum. Visit to Fragonard Musée du Parfum. Free time for shopping in the evening.

Get set to visit the Palace of Versailles, a world-famous palace located in Versailles, about 12 miles (19 km) west of Paris, France. The palace is owned by the French Republic and has since 1995 been managed, under the direction of the French Ministry of Culture, by the Public Establishment of the Palace, Museum and National Estate of Versailles. 15,000,000 people visit the Palace of Versailles every year, making it one of the most popular tourist attractions in the world.

Next proceed to visit The Louvre Museum, the world's second-largest art museum and a historic monument in Paris, France, and is best known for being the home of the Mona Lisa. A central landmark of the city, it is located on the Right Bank of the Seine in the city's 1st arrondissement. Later you will visit The Musée du Parfum, also known as the Fragonard Musée du Parfum. During tour unveiling the manufacturing secrets of perfume and its extraordinary history from Antiquity to the present day. Evening is free for shopping.

Day 07 –

Enjoy your fun filled day at Disneyland® Paris – 1 Day 1 Park (Disney® Parks OR Walt Disney Studios® Park). Paris by Night Tour.

Breakfast at hotel

Check out from your hotel and we drive Brussels. Brussels is known all over the world as the Capital of Europe, but it has many more, lesser-known attractions: an amazing variety of architectural styles including the internationally renowned Grand Place and Art Nouveau districts. On arrival in Brussels, transfer to your hotel for check-in.

Later proceed for orientation tour of Brussels. Visit one of Europe's most beautiful squares, the Grand Place, home to the medieval Town Hall and the fabled Manneken Pis statue. Drive past St. Michael's Church and stop for a photograph at the Atomium. Later we will visit Mini - Europe (miniature park) located in Brupark at the foot of the Atomium, in Brussels. Mini-Europe is a park featuring all the wonders of Europe, in miniature. Bonsai trees, flowery groves and dwarf trees embellish the 350 monuments which have been reproduced at scale 1/25. A fascinating presentation for everyone, not to be missed during your stay in the Capital of Europe Union.

Meal Plan: Breakfast | Lunch | Dinner

Day 09 –

Onto Netherlands. Visit Keukenhof Gardens (till 14th May) Or visit the miniature park – Madurodam (from 15th May). Explore Amsterdam with Canal Cruise. Visit to Zaanse Schans and also Visit to Wooden Shoe & Cheese making factory.

Today after breakfast, check out from your hotel and relax in your coach as we proceed to the city of Lisse to tour the legendary Keukenhof Gardens (till 14th May). Be astounded by the vast numbers of tulips, daffodils and hyacinths, that create dazzling ranges of colour. From 15th May we visit Madurodam, a miniature park to see a range of perfect 1:25 scale model replicas of famous Dutch landmarks, historical cities and large developments. Feel like a giant amidst models of palaces, canals, windmills, harbors, airport and other Holland attractions. Later drive to the Dutch capital – Amsterdam. Board a glass-topped boat where you will experience the best of this historical city. Thrive on the city's vibrant past with its 1,000 bridges and quaint old houses. visit to Zaanse Schans

Later we will visit to Zaanse Schans is a neighborhood of Zaandam, Netherlands. If you wish to get an accurate impression of life in Holland in the 17th and 18th centuries, visit to Zaanse Schans. It is best known for its collection of windmills and wooden houses. On arrival we will also have visit to local Clog and Cheese making factory. Witness a demonstration of how cheese is made. You also have a chance to savour some authentic Dutch cheese. Watch a shoemaker make clogs and wooden shoes carved out of wooden blocks.

Day 10 –

Visit Cologne Cathedral. Onto Heidelberg. Orientation tour of Heidelberg.

This morning, after breakfast, check-out from the hotel and proceed to the city of Cologne, famous for its Eau de Cologne. Here you will visit the imposing Cologne Cathedral, a Gothic masterpiece with its 515 feet twin towers. Later we will continue our journey towards Heidelberg. On arrival, proceed for an orientation tour. Visit Heidelberg Altstadt (Old Town) which spreads around the Market Square and stretches along the Neckar River. Sit just below Heidelberg Schloss (castle) it hosts old and modern houses in a maze of narrow, cobblestoned streets. Continue your drive to your hotel and check in.

Meal Plan: Breakfast | Packed Lunch | Dinner

Day 11 –

Drive to Geneva. Enroute visit Black Forest. Orientation tour of Geneva.

Check out relax in your coach as we drive to the heart of the Black Forest, known for its dense, evergreen forests and picturesque villages. You will be enthralled at the scenic beauty of the quaint villages in the heart of Black Forest region. Witness a demonstration of how cuckoo clocks are made. Sit back and enjoy the scenic drive towards Switzerland. Later proceed to Switzerland, a mountainous Central European country, home to numerous lakes, villages and the high peaks of the Alps. On arrival proceed for orientation tour of Geneva. See The Jet d'Eau, a large

fountain in Geneva, Switzerland and is one of the city's most famous landmarks, UN Buildings - The United Nations Office and the Flower Clock, located just in front of the famous Lake Geneva.

Later drive to your hotel and check in.

The town is located between two lakes, Brienz and Thun, and alongside the river Aare, which flows between them. This town is very famous for Bollywood and Hollywood movies. Later you proceed to Grindelwald. The new 3S-Bahn Eiger Express takes you from the Grindelwald Terminal to the Eigergletscher station in just 15 minutes. From there board a cogwheel train to reach the highest railway station in Europe at 11,333 feet – a world of eternal ice and snow. Visit the Ice Palace where artists create their work of art in ice. Visit the Sphinx observatory deck to experience a breath-taking panoramic view of the longest glacier in the Alps - Aletsch Glacier.

Day 13 –

Visit Mt. Titlis- enjoy Cable car rides including the world’s first rotating cable car, the Rotair – to the top of Mt. Titlis at 3,020 metres. Orientation tour of Lucerne. Enjoy Cruise on Lake Lucerne.

Breakfast at hotel

Today enjoy amazing scenery, a once in a lifetime experience with an exhilarating tip to the top of Mt Titlis at 3020 metres on various cable cars including Rotair, the world’s first revolving cable car. Get a breath taking unrestricted 360 degrees stunning view of the dazzling snow capped peak, deep crevasses and pristine white snow fields, dotted with massive ice boulders from every angle. Do not forget to visit the “Cliff Walk” the highest suspension bridge in Europe along the cliff of Mt.Titlis. Later proceed on an orientation tour of Lucerne one of most beautiful cities in Switzerland. Visit the Lion Monument, Kapell Brucke with some free time to shop for famous Swiss watches, knives and chocolates. Later enjoy a scenic cruise on the lake of Lucerne. Admire views of the lake, the town and the Swiss Alps during the lake lucerne cruise.

Overnight stay at hotel in Central Switzerland

Meal Plan: Breakfast | Lunch | Dinner

Day 14 –

Visit Swarovski Crystal Museum – the dazzling world of crystals. Visit Innsbruck – The Tyrolean capital of picturesque Austria.

Breakfast at hotel and check out

Relax in your coach as you take a scenic drive to Innsbruck. Proceed to Wattens, to visit the Swarovski World of Crystals and marvel at the crystalline works of art. Later enjoy an orientation tour of the beautiful city, Innsbruck. See the Golden Roof with its fire gilded copper tiles, a characteristic landmark of Innsbruck, walk down cobblestone pathways of Maria Theresien Strasse. You can sit at one of the many outdoor cafes, admire the magnificent baroque architecture and relive medieval European culture. The splendid Alps in the background provide a perfect picture-postcard setting.

Overnight stay a hotel in Innsbruck / Seefeld

Meal Plan: Breakfast | Lunch | Dinner

Day 15 –

Welcome to Venice - the floating city of Italy. Enjoy Gondola ride.

Breakfast at hotel

Check out of your hotel and proceed towards Venice – Italy. City of Beautiful Monuments, Serpentine Canals, city that inspired poetry and passion through the ages. Arrive at the pier in Venice, where we board a private boat. Enjoy your Indian lunch on board while you sail over the Giudecca Canal, to arrive at St. Mark's Square – the main square of Venice. View St Mark's Basilica - one of the best examples of Byzantine architecture,

Witness the famed Bell Tower and Clock Tower with the dominant sign of the Zodiac and current phase of the moon. See the Bridge of Sighs, made of white limestone, that passes over the Rio di Palazzo, connecting the old prisons with interrogations rooms at the Doge's Palace. Witness a Murano Glass demonstration and marvel at the intricate and colorful glass artefacts, hand-crafted by master craftsmen. Treasure a romantic Gondola ride in a flat-bottomed Venetian rowing boat, amidst the stunning backdrop of baroque buildings. This truly is the best way to enjoy this enchanting city. We return to the pier and later check in to your hotel.

Day 16 –

Visit Ferrari Museum. View the remarkable and famous Leaning Tower of Pisa.

Today after breakfast we will check out & drive to Maranello to visit the Ferrari Museum. Museo Ferrari is a Ferrari company museum dedicated to the Ferrari sports car marque. It is located just 300 m (980 ft) from the Ferrari factory in Ferrari's hometown of Maranello, near Modena. Later drive to Square of Miracles with the stupendous Leaning Tower of Pisa.

Overnight stay at hotel in Tuscany region.

Meal Plan: Breakfast | Lunch | Dinner

Day 17 –

Guided walking city tour of Florence. All roads lead to Rome – the eternal city. Rome by Night Tour.

Today check-out and proceed for guided tour Along with your English-speaking local guide, walk and absorb into the culture of the historic city. View the Duomo – the city's most iconic landmark, the Campanile and the Baptistery with its Gates to Paradise. Also see the Piazza Della Signoria – an open-air museum crammed with Renaissance sculptures, edged by historic cafes and presided over by the magnificent Palazzo Vecchio and the famed Ponte Vecchio (bridge) across the River Arno. Later proceed towards the eternal city of Rome. It is the most visited city in Italy and third most populous city in the European Union. Rome is full of secrets and has a very long history that spans millennia, and its attraction only seems to increase with each passing year. Later see Rome's breathtaking sights by moonlight. We will take you to the city's most important landmarks and monuments, including the Coliseum, Castel Sant'Angelo, and St. Peter's Basilica during our Rome by Nights tour.

Day 18 –

Guided city tour of Rome. Visit the world's smallest country – the Vatican City. (Which includes Vatican Museum, Sistine Chapel & St. Peter's Basilica) Entrance to Colosseum.

Enjoy a guided city tour of Rome with an expert English-speaking local guide. Next visit the Vatican City – the smallest country in the world (Please note shorts or sleeveless vests are not allowed). Enter the Vatican Museum, where you see the renowned classical sculptures and masterpieces of the Renaissance Art. Visit Sistine Chapel – a source of inspiration for art lovers and tourists alike and known for its masterpiece – the Last Judgement. This is also where the Pope gets elected. Visit the divinely beautiful basilica of St. Peter's. Get mesmerized by the works of Michelangelo and Bernini. Later proceed to visit Colosseum and learn about the incredible history and horrors of the Eternal City as you explore the centre of Ancient Rome. It is hard to imagine what these iconic landmarks would have looked like in their prime, with entrance to the archaeological site. The Colosseum is the world's largest amphitheatre, built by the Romans in 80 AD. Next, Visit the beautiful Trevi Fountains. The Legend says that tossing a coin over your shoulder gets you back to Rome.
