### **Waitomo Glowworm Caves Guided Tour**

An ancient world 30 million years in the making brought to life by the tour guide through story-telling its history, features and legends. Stunning, delicate cave formations and a boat ride through the starry wonderland of *Arachnocampa Luminosa*, thousands of magical glowworms, unique to New Zealand. Allow 45 minutes. Photography is not permitted in this cave.

### **WAITOMO MATAMATA and HOBBITON - Approx. travel time 1½ hours**

Today's journey takes you across rolling green countryside and lush pastureland. Continue through the leafy oak trees of Cambridge towards the rural town of Matamata. Well known for its thoroughbred horse industry and dairy farming heritage, the Hobbiton Movie Set now provides Matamata's biggest attraction.

Your guide will take you on fully guided tour around the set pointing out the most famous locations and explaining how the movie magic was made. ### **MATAMATA ROTORUA – Approx. travel time 1 hour**

We recommend travelling to Rotorua via Tirau, a vibrant and busy little town with quirky corrugated iron buildings. Further on, at Fitzgerald Glade, the lush ferns and pretty tree canopy signals the approach into Rotorua. A geothermal hot spot, Rotorua is full of steaming vents, spouting geysers and bubbling mud pools. The city is surrounded by mountains, rivers, forests and lakes with natural hot springs perfect for bathing and relaxing. Rotorua is the heartland of Maori culture and an ideal place to experience the traditional customs of New Zealand's indigenous people.

### **Agrodome Farm Show**

Agrodome is just a 10-minute drive from Rotorua city centre, in the heart of a real 350-acre working New Zealand farm. You'll hear amazing facts and have a few laughs as you're introduced to 19 breeds of sheep. Witness a live sheep shearing demonstration and the remarkable farm dogs as they demonstrate their ability to respond to

commands and keep those sheep in line. Your visit includes access to the Farmyard Nursery, home to the smallest, cutest animals at the Agrodome. Pet and have your photo taken with cute lambs and other baby farm animals. Then pop across to the herding area to watch a free live dog trial after the show. Allow: 1 hour

### **Te Ra Guided Experience**

Just seven minutes from central Rotorua lies the geothermal valley of Wakarewarewa Thermal Reserve and Pohutu geyser. Enjoy a 90 minute guided tour through the greenstone, wood carving and flax weaving schools at the Maori Arts and Crafts Institute, the Kiwi Conservation Centre and the geothermal valley and geyser.

Wellington is New Zealand's capital city. Set between a sparkling harbour and forest clad green hills, this compact city is home to New Zealand's National Museum and is best explored on foot.

**Half Day City Tour** by private touring vehicle :

A half day sightseeing tour covers the city highlights including Canterbury University, Riccarton House and Bush, Hagley Park, Museum and Botanical Gardens.

#### **Antarctic Centre XPRESS PASS**

Visit the **International Antarctic Centre**. Discover life down on the Ice with exhibits provided by the New Zealand Antarctic Programme. Enjoy the "the Snow & Ice Experience", the custom-built polar room. Explore the Gallery area and replica Antarctic field camp.

#### **Willow Bank Wildlife reserve or Orana Wildlife Park Admission**

Set in 180 hectares, Orana Wildlife Park is New Zealand's only open range wildlife park. The Park cares for over one thousand animals representing 90 different species, many of which are critically endangered. Hop on board the complimentary Safari Shuttle driven by a wildlife expert who provides a commentary whilst driving a 25 minute circuit of the Park. See New Zealand's iconic native species including kiwi, kea and tuatara.

## Day 07: Thursday the 02<sup>nd</sup> of May 2024

#### CHRISTCHURCH MT COOK - Approx travel time 4½ hours

Departing Christchurch, a lush patchwork of flat, green farmlands surround you as you traverse some of the most impressive, braided rivers in the world. Enroute, the charming village of Geraldine provides for a convenient halfway refreshment stop. At Lake Tekapo the Church of The Good Shepherd, sitting solitary at the edge of the vivid blue lake, offers a popular photo opportunity. Continue on the spectacular scenic drive through dramatic and vast landscapes to a rugged land of ice and rock, home to New Zealand's highest mountain, Aoraki Mt Cook.

#### Aoraki Mt Cook

##### Sir Edmund Hillary Alpine Centre

The Sir Edmund Hillary Alpine Centre's 126-seat custom-designed theatre is a tribute to Sir Edmund Hillary, humanitarian, ambassador and one of the world's greatest explorers, the center showcases the Aoraki Mount Cook region, its people and its place in the universe.

##### Glacier Explorer Seat in Coach

Depart Mt Cook Village on a bus trip to Tasman Valley followed by a 25-minute alpine walk to board a boat tour like no other. Surrounded by snow-capped alps, you will be expertly guided through the ice age as you view the gigantic Tasman Glacier Ice wall. Explore and learn about the ever-changing glacial landscape and listen to the huge ice-face melting in this peaceful glacial lake. Icebergs of every shape and size periodically tear away from the face of the glacier into the rapidly growing lake. This is one of the few accessible glacial lakes containing icebergs in the world. Duration 2.5 hours.

##### Big Sky Stargazing Seat in Coach

Experienced guides provide an introduction to the southern night sky using the naked eye, Astro-binoculars and state of the art astronomy telescopes. The tour is delivered either from an outdoor viewing platform or, if the weather is unfavourable, a 'live' orientation indoors in the 360 digital Dome Planetarium theatre.

#### MT. COOK QUEENSTOWN - Approx travel time 3½ hours

Return along the shores of beautiful Lake Pukaki to rejoin the main highway. The fascinating towering pinnacles of the Clay Cliffs are situated just before Omarama where you will take the southern route through the beautiful and dramatic Lindis Pass. The journey then whisks you alongside lakes and rivers through Cromwell, a historic mining town known for its stone fruit, to the sophisticated resort town of Queenstown. With its majestic mountains that plunge into crystal clear Lake Wakatipu, Queenstown is a hub of adventure, buzzing with adrenaline and a smorgasbord of outdoor activities.

#### Arrival Queenstown

Half Day City Tour by private touring vehicle

#### KJet Express Jet Boat Ride

Departing from central Queenstown, travel up to speeds of 95kph and experience 360 degree spins and acceleration in a high powered twin engine Jet Boat. The express 30 minute jet boat experience is perfect for the time conscious traveller.

#### Skyline Gondola Ride

Take in the stunning views as you ride the Skyline Gondola cable car to the top of Bob's Peak above Queenstown and Lake Wakatipu for a spectacular 220-degree panorama with breath-taking views.

#### Cave Tour at Gibbston Valley Winery

Located just a 25 minute drive from Queenstown, Gibbston Valley Winery is world renowned for crafting award-

winning Central Otago Pinot Noir and New Zealand's largest wine cave. Starting in the beautiful and historic Home Block Vineyard originally planted by the founder, your Cellar Door host will take you for a walk through the vines and down to the wine cave for three delicious tastings of current release wines. Allow: 30 minutes

## **Day 09: Saturday the 04<sup>th</sup> of May 2024**

### **QUEENSTOWN MILFORD SOUND QUEENSTOWN**

#### **QUEENSTOWN MILFORD SOUND – Approximate travel time 5½ hours**

Follow the southern arm of Lake Wakatipu where the Devils Staircase rest area and viewpoint is a highlight. Continue to Mossburn before joining SH94 and heading to the lakeside township of Te Anau, an ideal place to pick up any last minute supplies.

Not just a journey, the Milford Road is a destination in itself with the scenic highway featuring spectacular alpine scenery. Be sure to stop at Eglinton Valley to appreciate the beauty and sheer scale of the landscape. View the spectacular reflections of the Earl Mountains at the Mirror Lakes and keep an eye out for Kea, New Zealand's cheeky mountain parrot on the way.

#### **Milford Sound - Milford Sound Cruise - Sovereign at 1.15pm**

Experience spectacular Milford Sound where sheer granite cliffs tower into the sky and plunge into the depths of clear water while Mitre Peak stands like a massive sentinel, guarding this amazing fiord. Depart Milford on a full length cruise with views of waterfalls, rainforest and wildlife easily enjoyed from large windows, spacious decks and comfortable lounges. Experience the spray of a waterfall as you cruise close to sheer rock faces and watch out for dolphins, seals and penguins. Informative, participative, and relaxed, this is a perfect way to experience Milford Sound. Duration: 2 hours

#### **MILFORD SOUND QUEENSTOWN – Approximate travel time 4½ hours**

The return journey along the stunning Milford Road scenic highway provides the possibility of stopping for further sightseeing or photo opportunities that may have been missed on the way into Milford. At Te Anau, you'll turn inland to Mossburn then northwards to the little lakeside settlement of Kingston. Hug the shores of beautiful Lake Wakatipu as it meanders beneath the surrounding towering mountains as you take yet another scenic journey into Queenstown.

Board the historic coal fired vintage steamship, the TSS Earnslaw. Cruise from Queenstown Bay to Walter Peak High Country Farm (without going ashore) and return.

#### **4WD Skippers Canyon Tour Seat in Coach**

The Skippers Canyon 4WD tour departs from Queenstown heading out towards Coronet Peak. Highlights include The Plane Table, Skippers Canyon, Lighthouse Rock, Skippers Bridge, which provides a stunning photo opportunity. Skippers Schoolhouse and the cemetery divulges a wealth of information. On the return journey stop at Deep Creek and try a spot of gold panning. Some may also recognise spots along the Skippers Road as being featured in The Lord of The Rings.

There are two scenic drive options between Queenstown and Wanaka, over the mountainous Crown Range or alongside the rivers and lakes, through Cromwell. Wanaka is a perfect location for those looking for all the splendour of the southern lakes but a more relaxed ambiance than Queenstown.

#### Wanaka

#### Puzzling World Combo Admission

With a mix of bizarre buildings, rooms of illusion and the world famous Great Maze, this attraction is designed to challenge minds of all ages with its themes of wonder and trickery. Allow 1.5 hours.

### WANAKA GLACIER REGION - Approx travel time 5 hours

Travel past Lake Hawea via Makaroa to the Haast Pass. Although lower than the other alpine passes, Haast is the mightiest, surrounded by high peaks and forests, with many waterfalls visible from the highway. Continue north to the West Coast Glacier Region.

### Franz Josef Wilderness Tours - Approx. 02 hours Scenic Cruise 10am – 12 pm

Experience the true beauty of the West Coast on a personalised scenic cruise on Lake Mapourika set against a breathtaking backdrop of the Southern Alps and glaciers. Just seven minutes from the centre of Franz Josef township, Lake Mapourika was created approximately 14,000 years ago as the glacier retreated after a significant ice age. Known as a Kettle Lake, it's the largest mirror lake in the South Westland region. The surrounding tall peaks leave the lake calm and mirror-like with unbeatable panoramic views of glaciers and some of the tallest peaks in the country. The lake's Jurassic rainforest fringed shoreline is home to many native birds as they come to enjoy the lake's abundant fish and eels. Your knowledgeable skipper will provide local insight into conservation, the flora and fauna, and the natural geographical history of the area. Allow: 2 hours

### GLACIER REGION CHRISTCHURCH - Approx travel time 5½ hours

Travel through the scenic rainforest and past flowing rivers to Hokitika, known for its pounamu (jade, greenstone). Turning inland at Kumara Junction, take Arthur's Pass Road, the shortest, highest and most spectacular route across to the East Coast. Travel through the foothills of the mighty Southern Alps and alongside spectacular braided rivers until the flat green farmlands of the Canterbury Plains heralds your arrival in Christchurch.
